- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are limited to a 50% seating capacity in all areas. This means that all customers must be seated at tables, booths, or hightops.
- There will be **no standing** allowed, so our overall capacity is effectively reduced by 75%.
- Masks must be worn when not seated.
- Guest areas will be cleaned and disinfected after each guest.
- Tables are available on a first-come, first-serve basis and there is a 2-hour time limit.
- The St. Patrick's Day menu will be posted on our website.
- We are unable to take reservations as we are already greatly limited by the number of guests we can accommodate.
- The kitchen will be open from 8am to 9pm for:
  - "Kegs & Eggs" Breakfast: 8am 10am
  - o All Day Menu: 11am 9pm
- To help keep our guests safe, we will have our usual experienced security staff who have been working for us for years.
- There will be no cover charge, live music, or carryout orders on St. Patrick's Day.
